**Phone2Vote (P2V) – a powerful platform for serving democracy, and connecting leaders with citizens**

**Mission:** A leader will be accessible and supportive to each and every constituent, regardless of their status, color, race or size of the group they belong to – a democratic equalizer.

**Vision:** Leader and constituents team up to solve individual and constituency problems. Take out animosity and distrust in politicians, build friendships. Caring service leads to re-election.

**What is Phone2Vote?**

- 1) Overcomes barriers of geography, population and conflicting interests of multiple groups
- 2) Discuss and solve problems of individuals or community in short text or voice messages
- 3) Now it is the cheapest – free for most part – tool for the leader to connect with citizens
  - a. Most of the features, during promotion now, are available in the free version
  - b. All the features, including voice messaging, are given for a yearly fee
  - c. Flexible pricing or free, can be worked out depending on the particular situation

**How does Phone2Vote work?**

- 1) A simple constituency management tool with work flow, that can be used by a Councilor or School District representative, all the way up to a Congressman or a Senator
- 2) Combines online and SMS texting plus voice messages conveniently, very simple to use
- 3) It is convenient both as a personal tool for a leader (Apps on smart phone) or use by staff
- 4) It helps track performance of staff, response of people and progress of solutions
- 5) Citizen database may include a mobile, Zip code, voter ID, problem resolution history etc
- 6) Politician pays for the service and solves problems, builds a data base, earns loyalty

Go to <http://us.phone2vote.com>, log in, User Name: 1234567891 PW: 12345 – browse around

Then log out and click on “How does it work? Click here to see Phone2Vote Demo” link:

- 1) There are simple steps that give a good idea of how it works. You may begin with “Check Availability Right Now for Demo” link
- 2) Please call +1 949-545-9477 and follow the prompts to leave a voice message as a sample citizen (say something about your street, locality or a bill etc)
- 3) After step 2 b, go to “My Constituency”, then go to “Phone Messages” at the bottom, on the left. Then click on “Refresh” button at the top, on the left
- 4) Complete 2 b and 2 c, notice the number you have called from (if it is not blocked for Caller ID) on the top, next to the text “Mobile Number” – this is the number you called from. Then click on the right arrow mark below your number, your message is played
- 5) For a Citizen Page, you may either create one on your own or use this sample page:
  - a) User Name: 1234567880 Password: 12345
  - b) Then browse around to get an idea how it looks from a Citizen point of view
  - c) Please note that live data has been updated only for California, US
